Prophet's Knowledge Of Unseen (Ilm-e-Gaib)

Tafseer-e-Kabeer

Our beloved Holy Prophet (pbuh) has testified to the need for an Imam for every century.

The Promised Reformer Hazrat Mirza Bashiruddin Mahmud Ahmad (ra)

And We made them leaders who guided people by Our command, and We sent revelation to them enjoining the doing of good works, and the observing of Prayer, and the giving of alms. And they were worshippers of Us alone.(21:74)

And remember when his Lord tried Abraham with certain commands which he fulfilled. He said, 'I will make thee a Leader of men.' Abraham asked, 'And from among my offspring?' He said, 'My covenant does not embrace the transgressors.'(2:125)

For the above verse Hazrat Musleh Maud(ra) was elaborating in Tafseer-e- Kabeer as follows,

2404. Commentary :

God chose leaders of religious movements from among the progeny of Abraham in fulfilment of his prayer referred to in 2:125. A similar promise in regard to the raising of Divine Reformers in every age from among his followers was made to the Holy Prophet (Abu Dawud). This promise is also implicit in the famous prayer, i.e. Darūd, viz. "O Lord bestow thy blessings upon Muhammad as Thou didst bestow Thy blessings upon Abraham." Divine Reformers continued to appear among the progeny of Abraham till, with the rejection of Jesus by the Jews, they were deprived of this boon for all times and prophethood was transferred to the House of Ishmael in fulfilment of the above-said prayer. Divine teachers are now raised from among the followers of the Holy Prophet in every century to regenerate Islam. And they will continue to do so till the end of time.

O children of Adam, is here made to the people of the Holy Prophet's time and to the generations that are yet to be born and not to the people who lived in the distant past and followed Adam immediately

The fulfilment of the prayer implicit in Darūd establishes the superiority of the Holy Prophet over Abraham because whereas Divine teachers ceased to appear among the progeny of Abraham after Jesus, they will continue to appear among his followers as long as this world lasts.

Divine teachers are now raised from among the followers of the Holy Prophet in every century to regenerate Islam.

Hadith - A lively view

4897: "While we were sitting with the Prophet (ﷺ) & Surat Al-Jumu'ah was revealed to him, and when the Verse, "And [He (Allah) has sent him (Prophet Muhammad (ﷺ)) also to] others among them (Muslims) who have not yet joined them....(V.62 :4) was recited by the Prophet , I said, "Who are they, O Allah's Messenger(ﷺ)?" The Prophet did not reply till I repeated my question thrice. At that time, Salman Al-Fārisi was with us. So Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) put his hand on Salman, saying, "If Faith were at (the place of) Ath-Thuraiyya (pleiades, on of the highest star), even then (some men or man) from these people (i.e., Salman's folk) would have taken it"

4898: The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "Then **some** from these people (i.e. Salman's folk) would have taken it ." (in the above hadith)

IN CONTINUATION OF PREVIOUS EDITION....

Hazrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad, the Promised Messiah(a.s.) has explaining the concept of Zill (mirror Image) in his book "EkGhalati-Ka-Izala" (A Misconception Removed page no:12) as follows:-

"I have stated repeatedly that, in accordance with the verse: "Wa aakhariina minhum lamma yal-haquu bihim" And among others who have not yet joined them. (Surah Al-Jumu'ah 62: 4). As Zill, I am the same Prophet Khatamun Nabiyyin(sa). It was twenty years ago, in Brahīn-eAhmadiyya, that God named me 'Muhammad(sa) and Ahmad(sa) and declared me to be the Holy Prophet(sa). Thus, the status of the Holy Prophet(sa) as Khatamun Nabiyyin is by no means in peril due to my Prophethood, since the Zill is never independent of the original. Since I am Muhammad(sa) by way of Zill, therefore, the Seal of Khatamun Nabiyyin remains intact, and the Prophethood of Muhammad (sa) remains confined to Muhammad (sa). This means that in all events it is Muhammad(sa) who remains the Prophet and no one else."

And Hazrat (as) further elaborating the Holy Quran verse 62:4 in his same book (A Misconception Removed page no:17) that:-

In short, the term Khatamun Nabiyyin is the Divine Seal which has been set upon the Prophethood of Muhammad(sa). It is now impossible for this seal ever to be broken. What is possible, however, is that the Holy Prophet(sa) may appear in the world in the form of a Buruz, not once, but even a thousand times, and may, by way of Buruz, proclaim his Prophethood with all its splendour and perfection. The advent of such a Buruz was ordained by God Almighty, as He says:

"Wa aakhariina minhum lamma yal-haquu bihim" (Surah Al-Jumu'ah 62: 4).

Prophets are never jealous of their Buruz for he reflects their own image and character.

The Holy Prophet of Islam (pbuh) as a Father

Muhammad literally means much praised. Even before he made claim to prophethood, his own people knew him to be truthful and trustworthy. The Holy Prophet of Islam (pbuh) was the father of three sons and four daughters. Two sons, Qasim and Abdullah, named in the family Tayab and Tahir were born from Hazrat Khadija. Another son, Ibrahim, later on, was born from Hazrat Maria, his Coptic wife (who later became Muslim).

Hazrat Khadija had two children from her previous husbands, from one a son, and from the other a daughter, and both were called Hind. Apparently, the children remained with the respective families of their fathers, and came to visit her from time to time, to receive affection and gifts. The son, Hind Ibn Abi Hala seems to have been much attached to the prophet, his stepfather as later in Islam, he enthusiastically wrote about the Holy Prophet (pbuh) in touching terms: "... his mouth was like a box of rubies full of pearls, his face was more beautiful than the moon when it is full..." This reflects unmistakable intimacy, and an extraordinary love and respect.

According to Arab custom, when Zaid bin Harith was offered for sale, the Holy Prophet (pbuh) asked Hazrat Khadija to buy him. So Zaid bin Harith was bought and set free. The Holy Prophet (pbuh) and Hazrat Khadija then adopted him as their son and afterwards he was known as Zaid bin Muhammad. He lived under the Holy Prophet's protection and became a notably faithful companion and believer. Hazrat Zainab, the eldest daughter, was married to Abul-As bin Rabi bin Abd Shams,

Hazrat Ruqayya and Hazrat Umme Kulsoom were married to Utbah and Utaibah, son of the Holy Prophet's uncle Abu Lahab. As time passed and he proclaimed himself to be the prophet of Islam, Abu Lahab prevailed upon his sons to divorce his daughters Ruqayya and Umme Kulsoom and afterwards both sisters were married to Hazrat Usman bin Affan one after the other, after the demise of the first married. Both daughters died in the Holy Prophet's lifetime. Hazrat Fatima, the youngest, was married to Hazrat Ali and she was the only child that survived the Holy Prophet. She was deeply affected with grief by her father's death with the result that she died within six months of that event.

Almighty Allah blessed the Holy Prophet of Islam (pbuh) and Hazrat Maria, his wife of Coptic origin with a son who was named Ibrahim. It was an ecstatic occasion for the Holy Prophet (pbuh). It was natural that he expressed his affection for the newborn. The baby's mother, Hazrat Maria, also brought delight for the Holy Prophet (pbuh). He also generously rewarded the midwife Salma, wife of Abu Rafi. He celebrated the birth with great happiness



For he had a strong attachment for him since he had lost his two earlier sons, Al Qasim and Abdullah at a tender age His daughters, after they grew to maturity, married and bore children, but only Fatima survived from all his progeny. Naturally the death of all these sons and daughters who passed away one after the other and were buried by the Holy Prophet's own hands left him with a severe sense of bereavement It was, therefore, natural that a father who was so bereaved felt exceedingly joyful and .happy at the birth of Ibrahim.

Alas, the pleasure that Ibrahim brought to the Holy Prophet (pbuh) did not last long. Soon, the child fell seriously ill. He was moved to a date orchard near Mashabat Umm-i-Ibrahim, where his mother and Sirin, his mother's sister, looked after him. When his condition worsened and it became apparent that he would not live long, the Holy Prophet (pbuh) was informed and called. He was so shocked at the news that he felt his knees could no more carry him and asked Abdur Rahman ibn Awf to give his hand to lean upon.



The Holy Prophet (pbuh) proceeded immediately to the dwelling of his wife Maria and arrived just in time to bid farewell to an infant dying in this mother's lap. His heart was torn apart by the new tragedy, and his face mirrored his inner pain. Choking with sorrow, he said to his son:

“O Ibrahim, against the judgement of God, we cannot avail you a thing” and then he fell silent. Tears flowed from his eyes. The child lapsed gradually and his mother and aunt cried loudly and incessantly, but the Holy Prophet (pbuh) never asked them to stop. As Ibrahim approached death, the Holy Prophet (pbuh) with tears in his eyes talked to the child: “O Ibrahim, were that truth not certain that the last of us will join the first, we would have mourned you even more that we do now.” A moment later he said: “The eyes send their tears and the heart is saddened, but we do not say anything except that which pleases our Allah. Indeed, O Ibrahim, we are bereaved by your departure from us.”

The Holy Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) tried to suppress his sadness and lighten his sorrow. Looking towards Hazrat Maria and Sirin, her sister, he said to them in appeasement that Ibrahim would have his own nurse in Paradise.

Umm-i-Burdah, or according to another version, Al-Fazl Ibn Abbas washed the body of the child in preparation for the burial. He was carried on a little bed by the Holy Prophet (pbuh) and a number of Muslims to the cemetery of Al-Baqi, where, after a prayer recited by the Holy Prophet (pbuh), he was laid to rest. The Holy Prophet (pbuh) ordered the grave to be covered in. He filled it with sand, sprinkled some water and erected a tombstone.

He then said: “Tombstones do neither good nor ill, but they help appease the living. Anything that man does, God wishes him well.”

It is recorded that the Holy Prophet (pbuh) said: “Had Ibrahim lived, he would have been a true prophet.” (Kanzul Ummal).

The death of Ibrahim coincided with an eclipse of the sun, a phenomenon that the Muslims saw as a miracle. They went about saying that the sun eclipsed in sadness over the death of Ibrahim. The Holy Prophet (pbuh) heard them and said: “The sun and the moon are signs of God. They are eclipsed neither for the death or birth of any man. On beholding an eclipse, therefore, remember God and turn to Him in prayer.”

May Allah be always pleased and love our perfect role model and prophet Hazrat Muhammad (pbuh) and his family members and companions forever, and may He grace His Ummah with eyes of mercy and love and help us to bring back the glory of Islam by following the footsteps of our beloved master (pbuh). Ameen.

PLEASURE IN PRAYER

Hazrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad(AS) – The Promised Messiah

At times, it so happens that people are busy in their engagements and the call for Prayer is made. At such a time, there are those who would shut their ears, as though their heart begins to throb with pain. Such people are worthy of pity. There are certain people here as well whose shops are situated adjacent to mosques, but they never join in the Prayer. All I wish to say is that one ought to fervently and passionately pray to God Almighty that just as He has granted us diverse forms of pleasure in fruits and other things, may He enable us to experience, even once, the sweet taste of Prayer and worship. One never forgets the taste of a thing. If an individual looks at someone beautiful with pleasure, they remember it well. Further, if a person sees an ugly and hideous figure, the entire state of such a figure comes forth as an embodiment in the mind of the observer, whenever they are reminded of it. Of course, if a person is indifferent and saw the figure in passing, then one remembers nothing. Similarly, in the estimation of those who do not pray, the Prayer is like a penalty, whereby one is unjustly forced to wake up in the morning when it is cold and leave their precious sleep to perform ablution, and compelled to forsake many comforts in order to offer it. The actual fact is that such a one is averse and therefore, is unable to understand they are oblivious of the pleasure and satisfaction that is present in Prayer. How then can they experience pleasure in Prayer? I observe that when a drunkard or one who suffers from addiction is unable to find satisfaction, they

continue to drink glass after glass, until they are finally inebriated. A wise and prudent individual can benefit from this example. In other words, one must remain persistent in Prayer and continue observing it until they begin to experience pleasure. Just as a drunkard conceives of a pleasure in his mind, which is the actual objective he pursues, in the same way, the mind and all of one's faculties must feel a propensity towards the acquisition of that very pleasure that exists in Prayer. Then, with sincerity and passion, at least to the extent that an addict suffers from anxiety, restlessness and pain, an individual ought to pray that they are able to experience the pleasure they seek.

PLEASURE IN PRAYER

As mentioned in Holy Quran, Allah the Exalted has stated that good works or Prayer drives away evil. In another instance, God Almighty states that Prayer saves one from indecency and manifest evil. However, despite this we observe that there are people who observe Prayer, yet still indulge in evil deeds. The response to this is that they observe Prayer, but not in its true spirit, nor with piety. They only perform useless movements in the form of a custom and habit. Their soul is dead. Allah the Exalted has not described this as hasanat (or good works). In this verse, God has used the word hasanat as opposed to as-salat even though the two words mean one and the same thing. This is because God wishes to allude to the merit and husn (or beauty) of Prayer, which in its true form possesses within it a spirit of truth and the effects of divine grace. This form of Prayer does indeed drive away evil. Prayer is not simply a process of sitting and standing. In fact, the essence and soul of the formal Prayer is that supplication which possesses within it a pleasure and satisfaction.

In actuality, the essential parts of the Prayer are a symbolic representation of the form observed in spirituality. Man is required to stand in the presence of God Almighty and standing is also from among the etiquettes of servants. The bowing position, which is the second posture in Prayer, demonstrates that one submits themselves by lowering their head in preparation to fulfil any command that may be given to them, as it were. Moreover, the prostration expresses, through action, the greatest possible reverence, utmost humility and lowliness, which are the objectives of Prayer. These reverential practices and rites have been appointed by God Almighty to serve as a reminiscence of the deeper reality

cand so that the physical body may partake of the inner, spiritual essence. In addition to this, in order to reinforce in man the inner, spiritual rites, God has appointed outwardly, apparent rites. Now if in outwardly practice (which is a reflection of the manner observed at a deeper and spiritual level), one merely imitates certain apparent actions superficially and if one seeks to complete these actions only to rid themselves of a heavy burden, then do tell me, what pleasure and satisfaction can one gain from such practice? Until one is able to feel a pleasure and delight in Prayer, how can its reality be perceived?

PLEASURE IN PRAYER

This is only possible when the soul too falls in prostration at the threshold of God with a sense of complete self-effacement and humility; and when the soul too proclaims the words uttered by the tongue. It is then that a pleasure, light and comfort is attained.

It is my desire to write about this in further detail. A person undergoes various stages before they become a human being, i.e. starting as far back as sperm; in fact, even before this there are the constituent elements of the sperm, such as its nutrients, as well as their layout and construction. Then, after the sperm develops through various stages, it transforms into a child; children grow into adults, who finally reach old age. Hence, one ought to accept that it is the providence of Allah Almighty which nurtures human life through all of these diverse stages at various times and this entire state of affairs ought to remain firmly rooted in one's mind. It is only then that a person can prove able to lay forth their own servitude in the presence of God's providence.



In short, the fundamental point to note is that pleasure and delight in Prayer can only be derived when a relationship exists between man's servitude and God's providence. Until a person throws themselves before Allah Almighty, considering their own being to be nothing more than a complete non-entity or the like thereof—this being an inherent demand of divine providence—they cannot receive God's grace and light. However, when they do receive this blessing, they experience an intense pleasure, which cannot be matched by any other.


At this point, when a person's soul is humbled to the state of complete self-effacement, it begins to flow towards God in the form of a running spring and it becomes completely detached from all other relations beside Allah. At that time, the love of God Almighty descends upon such a person. At the time of this union, a unique condition is born through two surges of fervour: the fervour of providence surges forth from above and the fervour of man's servitude surges forth from below. This phenomenon is known as salat or Prayer.




My dear brothers, sisters and children,


Inspiration of the Mind v/s Divine Revelation

A very serious misconception which is prevailing in my time, in this era with a divine manifestation, and which has undermined the foundations of all religions, so that the very essence of religion is being completely revolutionized as a result of which, in place of the divine light of revelation, it is the ideas and conceptions of the human mind which are being substituted and put forward as the truth and thus it is that entirely erroneous definition of revelation which has found general acceptance. Independence of thoughts and the length of time which had elapsed since the appearance of the seal of prophets Hazrat Muhammad (pbuh) had led the greater portion of the world to believe that revelation was mere inspiration of the mind. This was due to the belief and conception that God could not speak in words as He was not a material Being and was not dependent upon material means like men.

I explain from my personal experience that revelation is conveyed in words and the mode of conveying is as certain and free from doubt as the talking of one man to another. If revelation was not to be conveyed in words, it could not be entirely free from doubt and could not lead to perfect certainty. For, perceiving every inspiration as divine revelation, every man can fancy himself inspired and thus deceive himself and mislead mankind, as has actually happened in several instances since this erroneous conception of revelation has found currency.

Revelation is conveyed in words possessing extraordinary glory and majesty, and also a dialogue is possible between God and man in the same manner as between two men, so that a recipient of revelation attains to that degree of certainty which dispenses with any further proof or argument



Revelation is intended to remove doubts and misconceptions, and if it is not conveyed in words, it opens, still wider the doors of doubt and uncertainty for there is then no means of distinguishing between revelation and the fancies of a man's own mind. Revelation is conveyed in words possessing extraordinary glory and majesty, and also a dialogue is possible between God and man in the same manner as between two men, so that a recipient of revelation attains to that degree of certainty which dispenses with any further proof or argument.



To the question whether God has a tongue with which He speaks, then let it be known that God is not dependent upon material means for the expression of His will and that, as He has created the universe without material hands and can see without material eyes, so He can speak without the aid of a material tongue. Indeed, when we say God speaks, we do not mean that He speaks with a tongue, but that He directs such movements in nature as express themselves in the form of words which are heard by the recipient of revelation. He does not himself stand in need of words, but man to whom revelation has to be conveyed stands in need of them. I am not merely claiming that revelation is conveyed by means of words, but through my experience, I have lived it, and Alhamdulillah, through this humble self's prayers, many people, my disciples, seekers of truth and other people since the beginning of the Divine Manifestation in Mauritius have been able to benefit from this spiritual power vouchsafed to me from the Almighty, and they also were and still are being able to receive such revelations, and these revelations are clear indications that the one to whom they are attached to, like a bee to a flower, like a branch to a tree, likewise, they are able to get light from the light of the light-holder, the special giver of lights which Allah has chosen for them in this era to bring you all out of the darkness of ignorance and sins.



What are the Basic Duties in Islam?

Therefore, O my dear brothers! Listen carefully, what Hazrat Masih maud(as) has repeatedly advised us that:-

the purpose that God Almighty has appointed for man in His Holy Word is as follows:

And I have not created the Jinn and the men but that they may worship Me. (The Holy Quran, adh-Dhariyat 51:57)

That is, I have created jinn and men so that they may know Me and worship Me. Thus the true purpose of man's life is the worship of God, His understanding and complete devotion to Him. It is obvious that man is not in a position to appoint the purpose of his own life, for he does not come into the world of his own accord, nor will he depart therefrom of his own will.

How can one say that prophethood is a false notion and that all prophethoods and purported Divine laws and books are only the imposture and selfishness of certain human beings.

As for those who say, 'Our Lord is Allah,' and then remain steadfast, the angels descend on them, saying: 'Fear you not, nor grieve; and rejoice in the Garden that you were promised. (The Holy Quran, Ha Mim as-Sajdah 41:31)

That is, upon those who, having believed in God, continue steadfast,

descend God's angels reassuring them: Fear not, nor grieve, and rejoice in the paradise that you have been promised. Here it is clearly stated

that the righteous servants of God receive revelation from God at times of fear and grief and angels descend upon them to reassure them. (Book **The Philosophy of the Teachings of Islam** page no:158-159)

And Huzur(as) further states that:-

our knowledge arrives at the degree of certainty by sight when we receive direct revelation and hear the voice of God through our ears, and behold the true and clear visions of God with our eyes. Without a doubt we are in need of direct revelation for the purpose of achieving such perfect understanding for which our hearts hunger and thirst in our beings. If God Almighty has not provided the means of such comprehension for us in advance then why has He created this hunger and thirst in our hearts? Can we be content that in this life, which is our only measure for the Hereafter, we should believe in the true and perfect and mighty and living God only on the basis of tales and stories, or should depend upon understanding or reason alone, which understanding is still defective and incomplete? Do not the hearts of true lovers of God desire that they should enjoy the delight of converse with the Beloved? And should those who have given up everything in the world for the sake of God and have devoted their hearts and lives to Him, (Book **The Philosophy of the Teachings of Islam** page no:189)

The entire good fortune of a person consists in this that he should run in the direction in which he perceives that light, and should adopt the way in which he discovers a sign of the Friend Who has been lost. You have observed that light always descends from heaven and falls upon the earth. In the same way the true light of guidance also descends from heaven. Man's own devices and his own conjectures cannot bestow true understanding upon him. Can you behold God without His manifestation? Can you see in the dark without the help of heavenly light? If you can, you may perhaps see in this case also. But our eyes, though in perfect condition, depend on heavenly light; and our ears, though they can hear perfectly, depend upon the air which circulates under divine direction. That god is not true who is silent and leaves everything to our conjectures. The Perfect and Living God is He Who manifests Himself on His own.

I assure all seekers that it is Islam alone which conveys the good news of that path. All other people have since long sealed up divine revelation. Be sure, however, that this seal is not imposed by God, but is an excuse that is put forward by man on account of his privation.



Can you see in the dark without the help of heavenly light? If you can, you may perhaps see in this case also. But our eyes, though in perfect condition, depend on heavenly light; and our ears, though they can hear perfectly, depend upon the air which circulates under divine direction.

Dear ones, no one can fight God's designs. Be sure that the source of perfect knowledge is Divine Revelation which is bestowed on the holy Prophets of God. Therefore God, Who is the ocean of grace, did not design that divine revelation should be sealed up for the future and the world should thus be destroyed. The doors of His revelation and converse are always open. If you seek them along their proper ways you will find them easily. The water of life has come down from heaven and has stopped at its proper place. What must you do, so that you might drink of it? You should, by some means or the other, arrive at that fountain and should put your mouth to it so that you might be filled with the water of life. 

And The Promised Messiah (peace be on him) has further explained about true meaning of Islam:-

Islam is the blazing fire that burns up our life and, consuming our false deities, presents the sacrifice of our life and our property and our honer to our Holy God. Entering it, we drink the water of a new life and all our spiritual faculties establish such a relationship with God as subsists between kindred. A fire leaps up from our inside like lightning and another fire descends upon us from above. By the meeting of these two flames all our passions and our love for anything beside God are totally consumed and we become dead vis-à-vis our previous life. This condition is named Islam in the Holy Quran.(Book The Philosophy of the Teachings of Islam page no:198-200)

In that condition the lower relationships of a person fall away from him, as ripe fruit falls away automatically from the branch of a tree. His relationship with God deepens and he draws far away from all creation and is honoured with the word and converse of God. The doors of access to this stage are as wide open today as they were at any time, and Divine grace still bestows this bounty upon those who seek it, as He did before. But this is not achieved by the mere exercise of the tongue, and this door is not opened by vain talk and boasts. There are many who seek, but there are few who find. Why is that so? It is because this stage demands true earnestness and true sacrifice. Mere words mean nothing in this context. To step faithfully onto the fire from which other people run away is the first requirement of this path. Boasts avail nothing; what is needed is practical zeal and earnestness. In this context God, the Glorious, has said:

And We are nearer to him than even his jugular vein. (The Holy Quran, Qaf 50:17)



That is, when My servants enquire from thee concerning Me, tell them I am close. I respond to the call of the supplicant when he calls on Me. So should they seek Me through their supplications and have firm faith in Me, that they may be rightly guided.(Book The Philosophy of the Teachings of Islam page no:131-132)

The method of establishing perfect spiritual relationship with God that the Holy Quran teaches us is Islam, meaning devoting one's whole life to the cause of God and being occupied with the supplications which we have been taught in Surah Fatihah. This is the essence of Islam. Complete surrender to God and the supplication taught in Surah Fatihah are the only methods of meeting God and drinking the water of true salvation.

Hazrat Ahmad (as) came for his century and has accomplished his mission as such for the salvation of the souls of his time, but God has promised him that He will preserve His Jamaat (community) and raise someone therefrom with the Holy Spirit to lead them. If all Muslims, including the followers of the Promised Messiah Hazrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad (as) realize that their salvation lies in submission to the will of God and as predicted by both the Holy Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) and Hazrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad (as), then they shall certainly recognize the Imam of their century, an Imam and Messiah, a Khalifatullah who has come from among themselves to guide them to the only God, the true, the only One Who is worthy of worship.

The people, Muslims and others have forgotten the essence of faith, the meaning of their Islam, of their commitment to the God Who gave them everything. A messenger of God confirms the coming of one who will come after him, so that people of intelligence (Ulul' al-Baab) recognize him. Prophets, messengers and reformers of God have similar, metaphoric, parabolic language; otherwise it will be too easy if people welcomed a messenger of God with open arms as soon as he comes. No, in the early stages it is only the "Ulul' al-Baab" who recognize them (the messengers) and then through their Dawa, Allah opens the other hearts, researchers truths, and even people who were once enemies of the messengers of God and give

them the most precious gift: faith, the true and pure!

Today in our present age that corresponds to the prophecy of the Holy Prophet (pbuh) that the Mahdi will appear 20 or 30 years after 1400 Hijri, because we are now in 1434 Hijri, and it's been ten years now that God raised me as His Chosen Messenger, the Messiah Muhy'uddin Khalifatullah.
